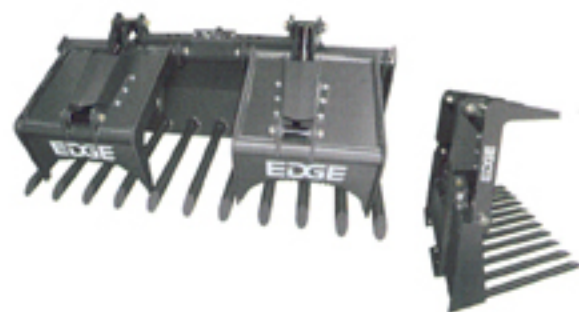


Grapples*

Handling brush, awkward debris, logs, and more is made easy with the right grapple. The experts at NA can help you to select the correct grapple based on your skid steer loader and your application.



Brush/Root Rake Grapple. The brush/root rake with grapple is ideal for loading awkward materials such as logs, rocks, and pruning debris. It works excellent for piling brush and lot clearing too! Good forward visibility makes for easy control in tight areas and increases productivity. A great tool for landscaping, forestry and agricultural applications.



Industrial Tine Grapple. Excellent for moving heavier, hard to handle materials such as logs, brush, and scrap materials. This heavy-duty attachment makes those tough jobs easy. Five models range in size from 60" (1524 mm) to 84" (2133 mm).



Utility Fork and Grapple. Designed to handle bulk materials, such as straw, manure, sod and silage, this versatile tool is a great addition to any attachment lineup. Fork and grapple are sold separately and as a set. This attachment is available in widths from 54" (1371 mm) to 78" (1981 mm).

Grapple Bucket. Move heavy, hard-to-handle materials on the construction site or anywhere you need to! Grapple buckets are available in widths from 63" (1600 mm) to 83" (2108 mm). They feature independently operating grapple arms for powerful clamping on uneven loads.
