

## Trenching

From a common trencher attachment to a unique silt fence installer, NA has many types and models of trenching attachments to fit the job.

**Trenchers.** Trenchers are one of the most common attachments for a skid steer loader. They are available in depths from 36" (914 mm) to 60" (1524 mm), and widths from 6" (152 mm) to 12" (304 mm). Various chain types are also available to suit the soil type and size of the project. Trenchers have a double flighted spoil auger and excellent wear on the drive sprocket.

### Silt Fence Installer.

This unique attachment allows an operator to install silt fence effectively and effortlessly by a single operator. With experience, an operator can install silt fence at a rate of up to 40' (12.2 meters) per minute! The offset blades return the soil to the trench creating a Z-shaped anchoring system, locking silt fence in place even before compaction. All that's left is installing the stakes and fastening the fence. The simplicity of the design means less maintenance, and the silt fence installer can be mounted (in place of the crumber arm) on any trencher.



**Trench Filler.** Covering 60' (18.3 meters) of open trench in 60 seconds is now possible with the trench filler. It eliminates tearing of the turf because the skid steer can straddle the trench and cover it in one pass. Available in right offset, left offset, or centered models. The trench filler is a necessary tool for large backfilling jobs.
